



Transfer Timeline

This timeline reflects your final year at AVC for Fall transfer

JULY

Apply July 1-31 for UC applications for Winter/Spring transfer. This is for select UCs and majors only.

AUGUST

Apply August 1-31 for CSU applications for Winter/Spring transfer. This is for select CSUs and majors only. <https://www.calstate.edu/apply/transfer>

SEPTEMBER

- For Winter/Spring transfers to a UC, submit your Transfer Academic Update (TAU)
- Sept 6: Priority deadline to submit graduation application for Spring & Summer graduates www.avc.edu/students/student-services/graduation-office
- Apply Sept 1-31 for UC Transfer Admissions Guarantee (TAG) application for Fall transfers. Only for those applying for UC TAG. Still complete a general UC application for the campus you're TAGging!

OCTOBER

- Apply Oct 1- Nov 30 for CSU & UC applications for Fall transfers. This is the traditional transfer timeline.

- Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) Verification
This is automatically verified and sent to the CSU, by the AVC Graduation office, as long as you reported that you're completing an ADT on the original CSU application. You can check your CSU student portal for more details. If courses are taken at another college, you must send a copy of proof of enrollment to graduation@avc.edu
- FAFSA or CA Dream Act (opens in October or later in the year, possibly December)

To be eligible for financial aid, including scholarships, be sure to complete before the California deadline

NOVEMBER

- CSU & UC applications ongoing, traditional deadline is November 30th
- Every year, CSUs & UCs announce if they extend the application deadline. Check for updated deadlines on the CSU & UC website.

DECEMBER

- After submitting university applications, be sure to check your email and university student portal regularly
Universities will send time sensitive instructions which include instructions when to send official transcripts, immunization records, etc. Only send official transcripts when the university requests it. Do NOT send them in advance.
- UC TAG applicants already received notice of their UC TAG status by now with time sensitive tasks to complete

JANUARY

- For Fall transfer to a UC, submit your Transfer Academic Update (TAU)
- Official transcripts & CSU/IGETC/CalGETC Certifications
You will be informed through your email or university portal when to send official electronic transcripts to the university. This includes CSU/IGETC/CalGETC Certifications. To order, go to AVC Transcripts online Parchment at: <https://www.avc.edu/transcript-office>
High school transcripts must be on file with AVC Transcript Office to receive full IGETC/CalGETC certification. Contact your high school to send electronically to AVC Transcript.
For your 2 free transcript hardcopies, send completed request form to transcripts@avc.edu and it'll be physically mailed.
- Out of state & private universities: research their websites for transfer application deadlines

FEBRUARY

- CSUs begin to send admissions notifications
- February 14: Priority deadline to submit graduation application for Fall graduates <https://www.avc.edu/students/student-services/graduation-office>
- Out of state or private universities: research their websites for their transfer application deadlines and checklist

MARCH

- March 2: Priority deadline for FAFSA <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> or CA Dream Act <https://www.csac.ca.gov/how-apply>
- Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) Verification
This is automatically verified and sent to the CSU, by the AVC Graduation office, as long as you identified you're completing an ADT on the original university application. You can check your CSU student portal for more details. If courses are taken at another college, you must send a copy of proof of enrollment to graduation@avc.edu
- CSUs send admissions notifications, ongoing
- UCs begin to send admissions notifications

APRIL

- CSU & UC send admissions notifications, ongoing
- AVC Commencement & other graduation ceremonies promoted, ongoing

MAY

- Request final official transcripts and CSU/IGETC/CalGETC Certifications to be sent to university and mark "hold for grades" and "hold for degree". This way your transcripts will be sent on time reflecting final grades and degree awarded.
Request them on Parchment <https://www.avc.edu/transcript-office>
- Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) due for UC
- AVC Commencement & ceremonies (take place only in the end of Spring term)
- Apply May 1-31 for UC Transfer Admissions Guarantee (TAG) applications for Winter/Spring Transfer. Only if you're applying for UC TAG. Only for participating UC campuses. Still complete a general UC application for the campus you're TAGging!

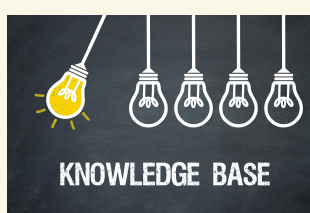
JUNE

- Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) due for CSU

JULY

- Official transcripts are due to CSU & UC reflecting the Spring semester grades. Send when the university requests them; not in advance.

HELPFUL TIPS



- Check your myAVC student email regularly (Microsoft Outlook)
- Stay in the loop with the AVC Transfer Center! They have helpful workshops that include: University application assistance, Transfer 101, Transfer Fair, and much more!
- Check your university portal regularly for up to date document requests and deadlines
- Consider joining the Honors Transfer Alliance Program (TAP) and get priority consideration to universities. For information, go to www.avc.edu/honors
- See a counselor once a semester and stay updated with your transfer requirements! Changes happen often.
- Be sure to complete your FAFSA or CA Dream Act on time to be eligible for federal aid and scholarships
- Graduation ceremonies are held in Spring only, but degrees/certificates are awarded in the fall, spring, or summer
- Apply to the AVC Foundation for scholarships at <https://www.avc.edu/foundation/foundation-scholarships>
- FAFSA, CA Dream Act, CSU & UC application deadlines can change per year. Verify the updated deadline at their appropriate websites
