1. Welcome	Zia Nisani	 The new hire for Anatomy & Physiology, Dr. Andrés Carrillo was introduced.
2. Dean updates	Christos Valiotis	 The modality of instructions for Spring 2022 was discussed. The faculty were informed that classes will be F2F and why hyflex model does not work for sciences. The faculty were encouraged to contact the dean if there are issues with covid reporting.
