The Ujima (Collective Work and Responsibility) Girls in Robotics Leadership (GIRL) Project aims to create STEM learning spaces for African American/Black girls to work collaboratively to address community and global issues. Using hands-on coding and robotics, cultural activities, and community-building, Ujima encourages attendees to serve as inspirational leaders by creating STEM clubs in their schools/communities. Participation is recognized as a UC -approved Educational Preparation Program on the UC undergraduate admissions application. Camp participants are also eligible for the Ujima GIRL Leadership Award.
