The instructional aide program provides the student with the skills, knowledge, and understanding that are needed to become a para-professional teacher's aide. Students earn work experience credit in the instructional aide program through work experience in the public school setting. The Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer (AA-T) Degree is intended to meet the lower division requirements for Elementary Teacher Education majors (or similar majors) at a CSU campus that offers baccalaureate degrees. This degree is designed for students interested in an introduction to the field of Liberal Studies, Integrated Teacher's Education and for students looking to further their understanding of Elementary Teacher Education. These courses will provide students with a solid foundation in Elementary Teacher Education that will serve them for transferring to a University.
