WHO MAY ENROLL

Classes are open to adults (18 years of age and older) who are not currently attending another high school. Married persons under age 18 and/or those who have custody of a child may also attend.

HOW TO REGISTER

Before registering you will need to have the following items:

1. A picture I.D.
2. Official transcripts from your last school. Official transcripts are transcripts that have been sealed in an envelope by your previous school(s). If your last school was a charter school or adult school you will need 2 sets of official transcripts: one set from the charter or adult school and one set from your previous regular high school. Do **not** open your official transcripts. You will need to bring these items with you to your appointment.

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA PROGRAM AT AVC

Credit toward the Antelope Valley Adult School high school diploma graduation requirements may be granted by the Adult School for many of the classes available at Antelope Valley Community College.

A 3-unit College class is equivalent to 10 high school credits. **A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA WILL NOT BE ISSUED UNTIL AN OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT IS RECEIVED FOR ALL AVC CLASSES BEING USED FOR THE DIPLOMA.** The following chart shows the Antelope Valley College classes which fulfill the various Adult School requirements. Acceptable courses from AVC must be numbered 100 or higher.

Health	Health Education 101
Electives	Courses numbered 100 or higher (no Physical Education accepted)

The Adult School does not require Physical Education (PE) and is not permitted by the Department of Education to grant credit for PE or any class designated as PE.
