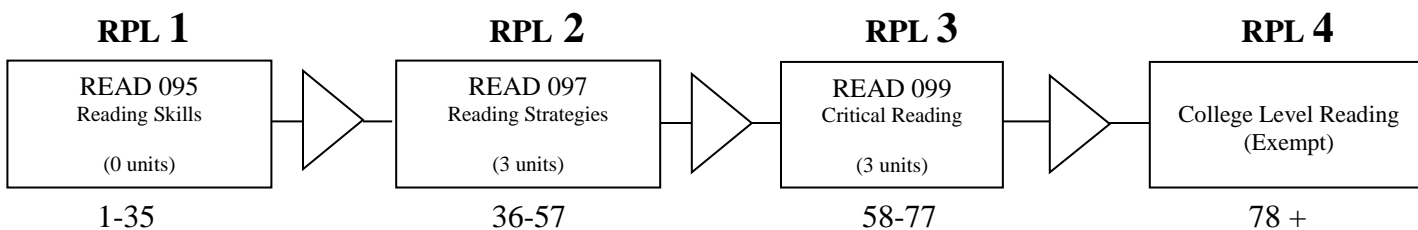


## COURSE PLACEMENT SEQUENCE FOR BASIC SKILLS and MATHEMATICS AVC ASSESSMENT

Students: Please refer to the following diagrams to find the course placement for your scores.

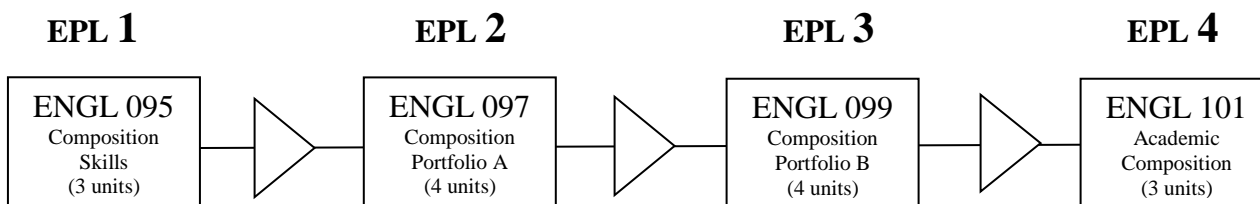

### Reading Scores (RPL):



Eligibility for COLLEGE LEVEL READING or completion of READING 099 is required for an AA/AS Degree. ADTs and Transfers to Universities do NOT require a Reading Proficiency. However, most courses advise for success a reading eligibility level that is measured by the results of AVC Reading Assessment.

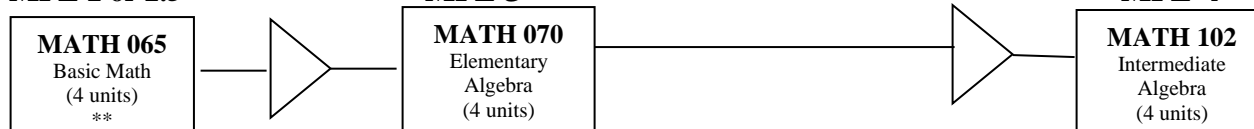
### Writing Scores (EPL):



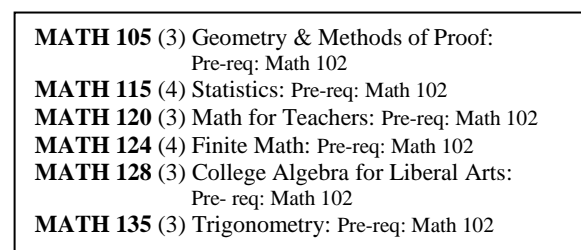
ENGL 101 with a grade of “C” or better is required for all Associate Degrees and Transfer.

### Mathematics Scores (MPL) Placement:

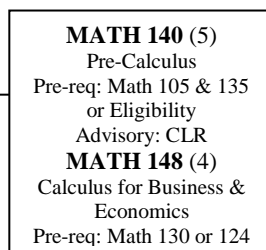
#### MPL 2 or 2.5



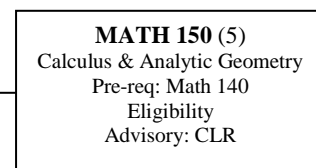
#### MPL 5

**Math 102 with a grade of “C” or better is required for Associate Degrees.**

### Note:

- A student may repeat the assessment (or any part of it) one time with a 24-hour waiting period between each assessment. The highest score achieved within the two attempts is used for placement.
- **Once a student establishes a transcript record in a class (Ws or letter grades), retesting for that subject is not allowed.**
- **Assessment test results are valid for three years.**
- The Mathematics department recommends MATH 105 and Math 135 be taken concurrently for STEM students. .
- Math 060 will not be offered after the Fall of 2013. A passing grade in Math 060 or 065 will allow a student to enter into Math 070. A passing grade in Math 050 will allow a student to enter into Math 065.
- \*\*Any student who has placed into Math 050 or Math 060 can enroll into Math 065.
- READ 097 did NOT exist in 14-15. The sequence that year was 095, 099, CLR. It came back for 16-17 and the placement and sequence are stated above.
