


2019-20 Foundation Scholarship Application Tips

- Click on Scholarships.



• Click on Student Scholarship Log-in.



You may see two application years. Be sure that the application has 2019 in the title.

<u>Click on either START APPLICATION or CONTINUE APPLICATION (Once your application is completed</u> the button changes to Review your answers)

Once your application is completed you can Manage your letters of recommendation. Add or delete a recommender or send a reminder email if they haven't completed it yet. (Be sure to keep in touch with them until it is done so that you can ensure that it is completed by the Deadline)

OBJECTIVE:

Your Objective does not need to go into details. Just one or two simple sentences that describes what you career goal is. The above sentence is just an example.

Personal Statement

Your Personal Statement must make an impression.

The key to writing a strong personal statement is to be personal and specific. Include concrete details to make your experience come alive. The 'who,' 'what,' 'when,' 'where,' and 'why' of your topic. The simplest experience can be monumental if you present honestly how you were affected. The personal statement should be written in Word, and then copied and pasted into the application. This way you will know your word count is correct, and you will have the ability to use spell check.

RECOMMENDED WORD COUNT: 400-500 words

Personal Statement *

- · State your educational goals and how this scholarship will assist you.
- · Include accomplishments, special circumstances, and future plans upon completing your education at AVC.

Minimum length: 300 words.

Maximum length: 600 words.

Sample essay for workshops: Not applying
