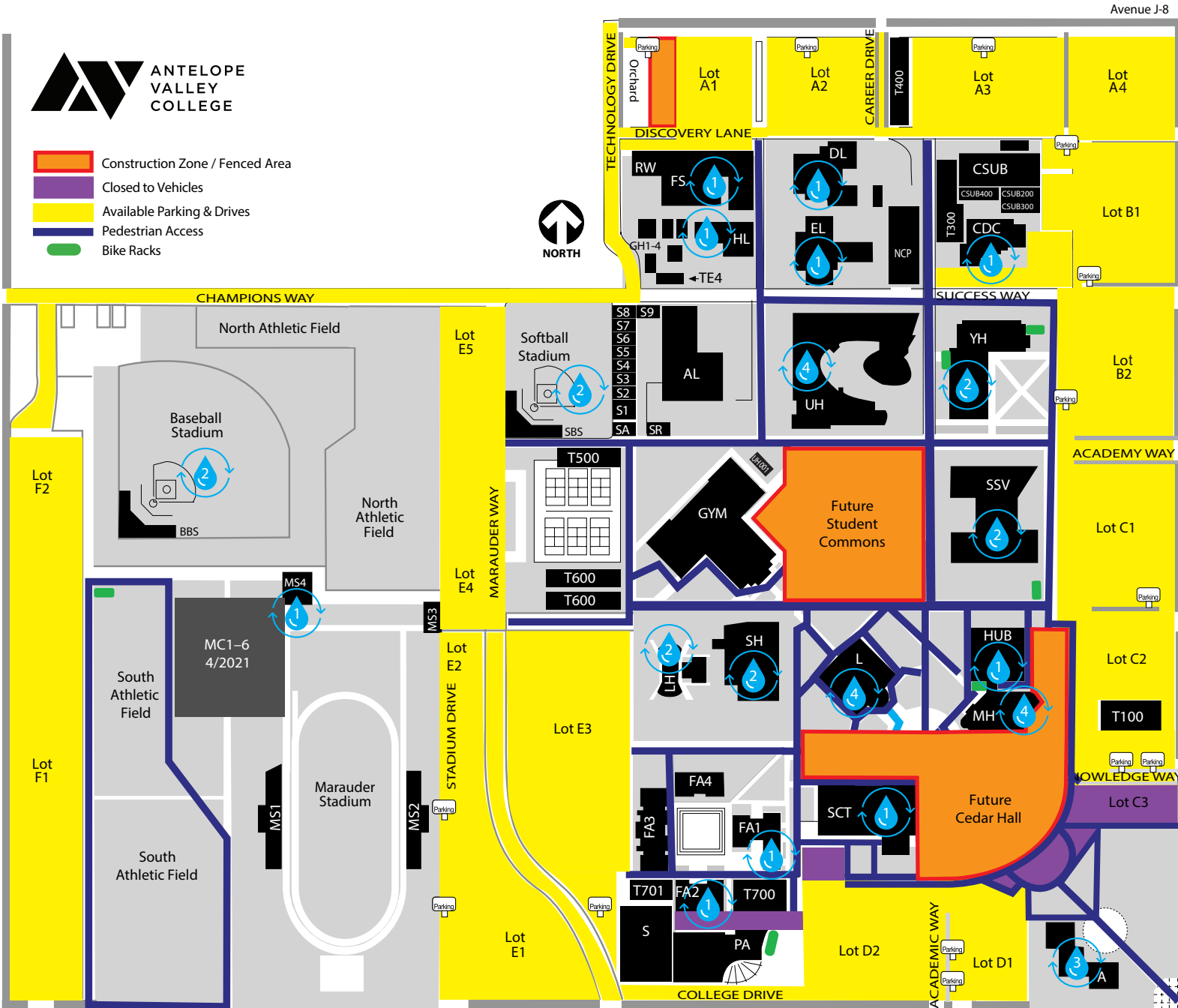

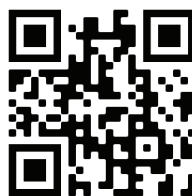

What is TimelyCare?

Access to 24/7 medical and mental health support for all Antelope Valley College students.

Who can use TimelyCare?

Any enrolled Antelope Valley College student can use TimelyCare.

What services are available?

24/7 Medical visits, TalkNow visits (24/7 mental health support) and Scheduled Counseling (12 visits per year) are available at no cost.

How do I log in?

Go to timelycare.com/AVC and follow the prompts.

**Mobile users will be directed to download the TimelyCare app.*

What can I be treated for?

Our physicians and counselors can treat/discuss a wide range of common conditions, and after talking to you, will decide on the best course of treatment. Some common conditions are: cold, sinus infection, influenza (flu), stress and anxiety, relationships and depression.

How much does a visit cost?

There is no cost to enrolled Antelope Valley College students.

I already have insurance and a primary provider, how does TimelyCare benefit me?

With TimelyCare, you will have free, 24/7 access to doctors and counselors from anywhere in the United States, so you'll never have to spend time or money looking for resources when you're away from home or campus.

Can I get a prescription?

Yes, if the provider deems it clinically appropriate.

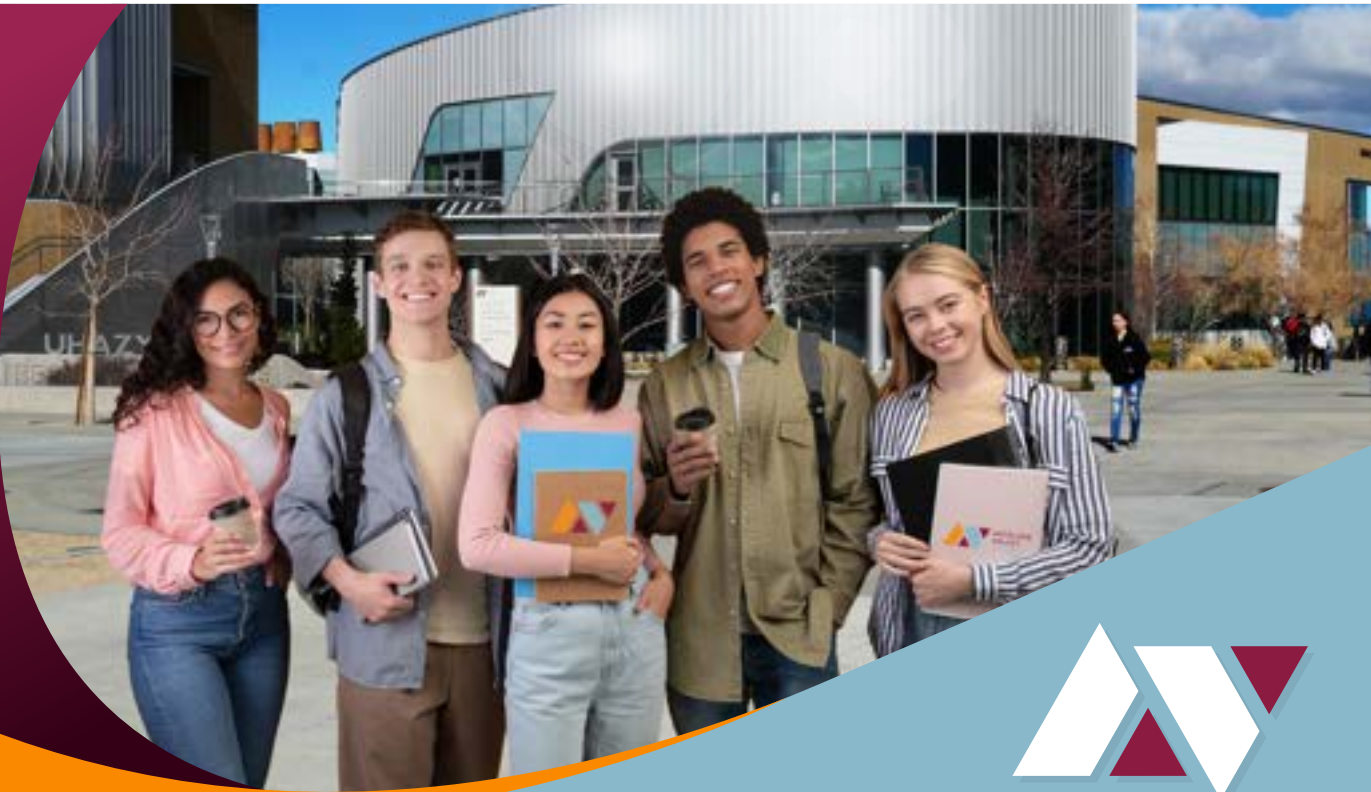

- Educationally disadvantaged

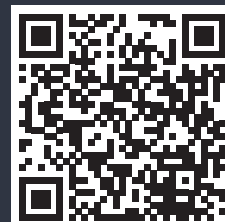

Got Kids?

We can help you with:

- **Academic Counseling:** – Need your Educational Plan updated, having a stressful semester? Unsure of classes to take next?
- **Book Requests:** We will submit your request to the county for approval to cover ANY books that are required for your AVC courses.
- **Child Care:** The County will provide childcare services for GAIN approved activities.
- **Ancillaries:** Supplies & Clothing – The CalWORKs office can submit a request to the county to cover costs for any required school supplies and/or clothing needs.
- **Transportation Funds:** Through the county, students can be provided transportation funds for any GAIN approved activities.
- **Scholarships:** There are yearly statewide scholarship opportunities for CalWORKs students.
- **Cash Grants:** When funds are available, the CalWORKs program can provide students with Cash grants who complete all program requirements.

Student Transition Academic Retention

A Student Support Services Program for Academic Success

WHAT IS THE S.T.A.R. PROGRAM?

S.T.A.R. (Student Transition Academic Retention) is a federally funded TRIO Student Support Services Program.

The program is designed to identify promising students and provide instructional support services above and beyond what is currently being offered. S.T.A.R. program staff are available to work on an individual basis with student participants to provide academic and personal support.

WHAT DOES S.T.A.R. PROVIDE?

Academic/Career Support

- Personalized education plan
- Priority registration
- Goal-setting and career counseling
- Progress monitoring
- Computer literacy and research assistance
- Tutoring in Math and English
- Four-year college visits
- Transfer assistance
- Computer lab

Financial Support

- Financial aid and scholarship application assistance
- Potential supplemental grant aid

Personal Support

- Personal counseling support
- Personal development workshops
- Cultural enrichment activities

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR S.T.A.R.?

Program eligibility is determined by Department of Education guidelines. You are eligible if you meet any of the following criteria:

- Neither of your parents graduated from college with a Bachelor's Degree
- You have a documented financial need
- You have a documented disability
- You have an academic need

In addition, to be eligible you must be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident.

The S.T.A.R. program is funded to serve 160 students annually, who are obtaining a certificate, associate degree, and/or transferring to a four-year institution.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR S.T.A.R.?

Students interested in applying for the S.T.A.R. program must complete a program application available at the S.T.A.R. office located in the Student Services Building, Second Floor or online at www.avc.edu/academics/programs-and-pathways/star →

- Participate in EOPS/CARE, DSPS, Puente, or MESA
- Participate in foster youth programs such as Guardian Scholars, FYSI, NextUp, extended foster care (AB 12/AB 212)
- Have dependent children under the age of 12
- Recieve CalWORKs
- Approved for work study
- Work 20 hours/week; or an average of 80 hours/month

Applying online takes just a few minutes. If you're approved, you'll get a free debit card for monthly groceries.

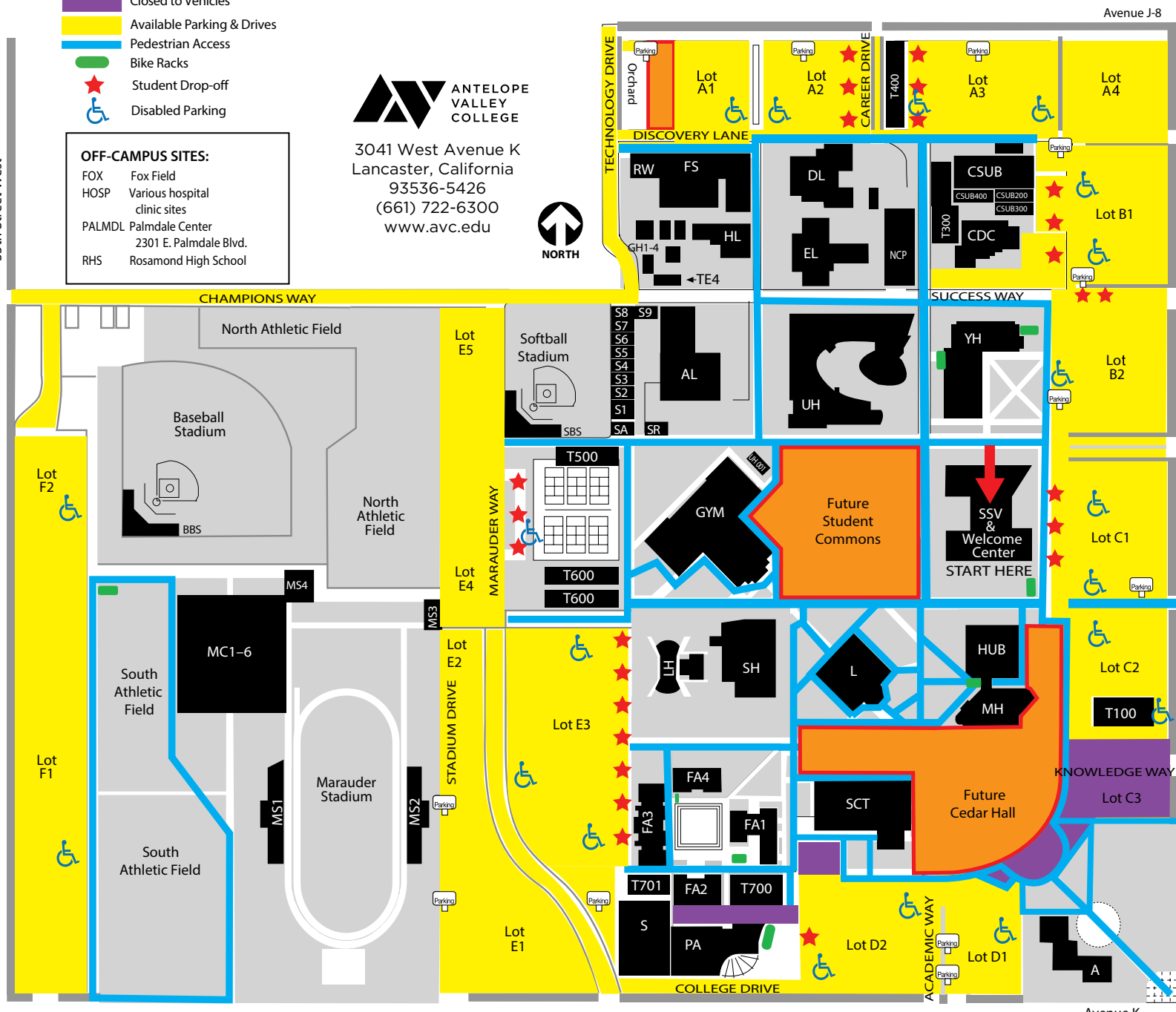

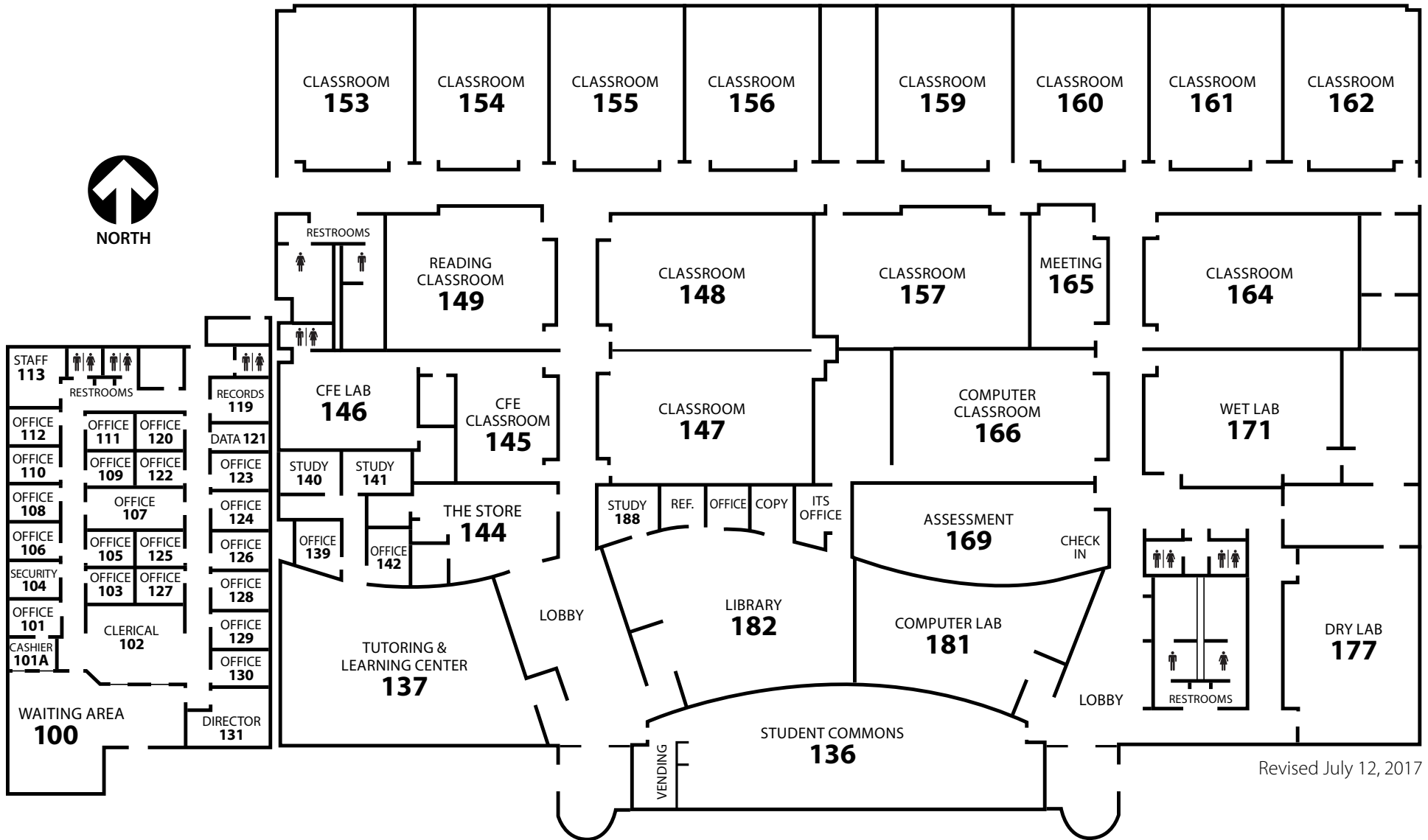
