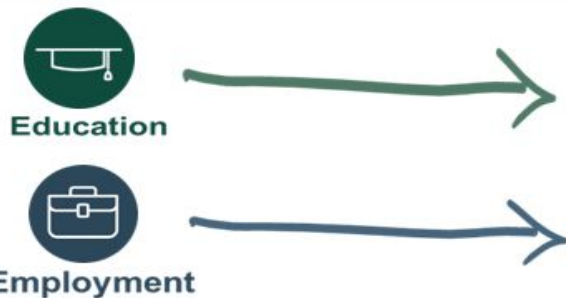

High school students experience disconnected pathways between education and employment

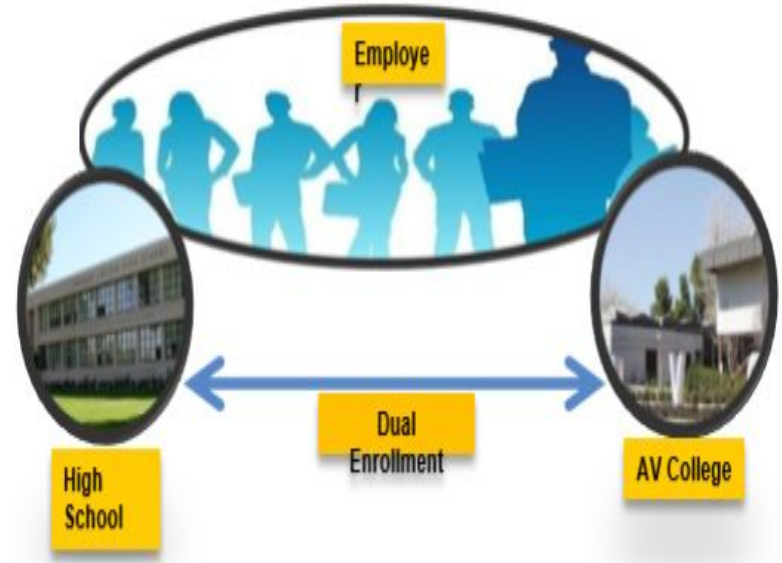


Braided Structure
High school students benefit from earn-and-learn pathways that give them academic preparation and job experience as they earn a college degree



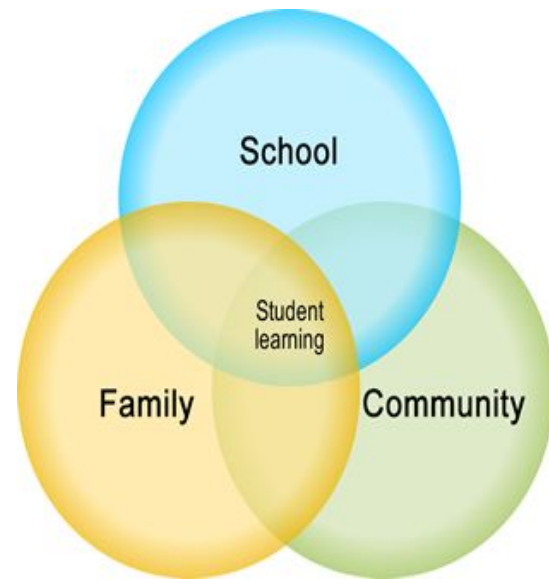
AVC Careers with Children and Families Pathways

- Earn as you learn career exploration
- Dual enrollment in high school and community college
- Paid on-the-job training
- Student Cohort Pathway
- Job Coach
- Academic Tutor



Certifications and College Degrees

- Earn 12 semester units of transferable college credits while dually enrolled in high school
- Earn an Associate degree in Child and Family Education (CFE) or Sociology (SOC).
- Achieve certifications necessary for permanent work status with public sector employers as well as nonprofit, and public health employers.
- Acquire child development permits issued through the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing



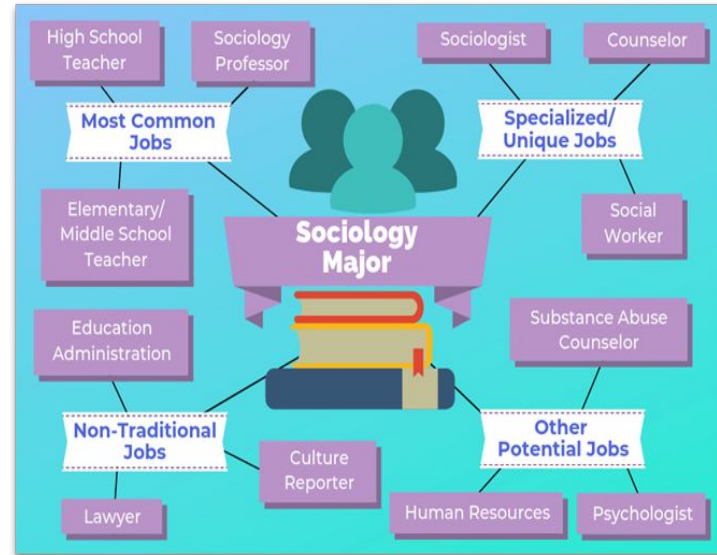
Paid Work Experience

- ❑ Early exposure to career options
- ❑ On-the-job skills training with local service agencies
- ❑ Work assessment and performance evaluations

Careers in Health and Human Services

- **Case Worker** (\$45,000 - \$55,000)
- **Social Worker** (\$55,000 - \$71,000)
- **Counselor** (\$57,000 - \$96,000)
- **Research Analyst** (\$40,000 - \$122,000)
- **Policy Analyst** (\$42,000 - \$82,000)



Careers in Child and Family Education

- **Early Education Teacher** (\$55,000 - \$71,000)
- **Professional Development Coach** (\$45,000 - \$87,000)
- **ECE Curriculum Specialist** (\$57,000 - \$84,000)
- **Parent-Child Educator** (\$37,000 - \$80,000)
- **Early Education Director** (\$64,000 - \$81,000)



Additional Program Benefits

- Academic guidance and tutoring
- On-the-job training
- Paid tuition, textbooks
- Fees paid for background checks and certifications
- Rewards for skill gains (i.e., wage increases)
- Work in diverse environments
- Supportive services
- Flexible schedules
- Become a Registered Apprentice after high school

Summer Job Placement	7 weeks (up to 280 hours)
12th Grade Fall Semester	SOC 101 - Introduction to Sociology
12th Grade Spring Semester	SOC 110 - Ethnic Relations
Summer Job Placement	7 weeks (up to 280 hours)
AVC Fall College Admissions	16 week semester (take 15 units for full time)
