



• What is email and how is it different from texting?

- How is an email to a friend/family member different than an email to a teacher or company?

THINGS TO REMEMBER WHEN WRITING AN EMAIL

- Use the right language professional or informal as needed.
- Use proper grammar, spelling, sentence structure.
 - Attention: ALL CAPS = SHOUTING
- Remember that email isn't private!
- Use the subject field to indicate the reason for your email.
- Be clear and concise in your words. Remember: Since the person whom you send the email to cannot see you when he/she reads it and therefore cannot hear your tone of voice or see your body language the words in your email are all the impression you can make.
- Be brief. Email is a quick communication tool.
- Make sure you have permission to forward anything you have received.
- Use a signature at the end of your email. Remember: your email address doesn't always have your name in it and the person receiving it won't know who they are getting this from. (Take a look at your school email does it give your full name?)

A QUICK LOOK AT GMAIL/AVC MAIL & ITS FEATURES

- As an AVC student you automatically have an email address from the college.
 - It looks something like this: <u>mlathrop2@avc.edu</u>.
 - First letter of your first name + last name + a possible number @ avc.edu
- You get to keep this email for life, unless you break college rules and policies.
- Additional Applications: Calendar, Google Drive
- Google Mail is the same as Gmail and is accessible from anywhere you have an internet connection.
- To log in you need your full AVC email address and your MyAVC password.
