Advisor's Report:

There is a leadership program with various topics discussed starting, September 22. The club that has the most members present will get a certificate of recognition. There is a club training day in the works, possibly right after an ICC

meeting. Dr. Zimmerman and Michelle are looking at possible dates. On September 28, there is a health fair and blood drive chaired by Beverly Manns.

-Alpha Iota: They will not be selling Krispie Kream donuts, they will be at the Taco Bell carwash fundraiser. They will have a Garage sale at Alita's house October 5th in Palmdale but no address was given. They will be doing a Baja Fresh fundraiser where 15% of the sales will go to Alpha Iota on Sept 30th and Oct 7th.

4.1 Club Activations/Deactivations

Moved to approve SNAC Fall 2006, by The Gamers, seconded by Physics and Engineering Club, Motion passed 6/0/0.

4.3 Events and Activities

Club Days summary by ASL: In the library plaza from 10:30 to 1:30. Each club will have tables. At the last meeting, Natalie asked the electrical requirements for sales. There was a suggestion about friendly competitions or a scavenger hunt but the consensus was "not enough time." Dr. Zimmerman reviewed what the clubs would sell. The Alliance-sodas .75, Gamers snow cones \$1.00, Alpha Iota -tickets, ASL -raffle

tickets \$1.00, APACE will sell egg rolls \$1 and T-shirts for \$3, Superacion will not participate. Dr. Zimmerman informed the clubs that when selling, Mandy must be informed so she can prepare cash boxes. Dr. Zimmerman asked if there was reimbursement for clubs. ASL confirmed \$50 reimbursement for each club as discussed in the last meeting. ASL spoke of a previous decision that if clubs do not return their receipts if taking an advance for the sales, they will be deactivated and suggested we should have the minutes from the last meeting where that was discussed. The Alliance asked for the sound system and Dr. Zimmerman reminded everyone that it belongs to ASO and it must be approved through them. ASL stated that Michelle had said a technician is needed to run it. Dr. Zimmerman suggested that if any club members want to learn how to run the sound system, she could arrange another training session. Dr. Zimmerman asked if anyone needs ice. The Alliance stated that they did and Dr. Zimmerman said that she would arrange for ice to be made available through the cafeteria.

A previous discussion to change the photocopy allotment for clubs from 100 to 200 a month was readdressed for Dr. Zimmerman's benefit since she was not aware of it. Dr. Zimmerman stated she was concerned about it since the cost comes out of her department's budget. She stated that it should not be a problem but she would discuss it with Mandy. Dr. Zimmerman also spoke about having placed a request for a color copy machine for the Student Development and College Activities Office and will let us know about that. President Scott asked if color paper or white paper was needed by clubs.

V. ANNOUNCEMENTS /UPCOMING MEETINGS AND EVENT

-The Alliance spoke of their upcoming movie night from 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm and stated that movies are picked by vote.

-Gamers spoke about an upcoming discussion with professor Rainbow.

-ASL asked when the next ICC meeting was and President Scott stated she did not know when the next meeting will be. President Scott stated she would ask Natalie when the next meeting would happen and that she would contact the clubs.

-Dr. Zimmerman asked if clubs have been receiving E-mail. The Alliance spoke about few E-mails being received about ICC meetings. The regular time of Friday at noon was addressed as being a good time. The issue of meeting rooms not being unlocked for meetings was discussed.
