They have done some successful high school fundraisers by selling smoothies to schools at a discount, then school sets price as desired. Options mentioned: discount, purchase in advance, have a promo day with a percentage to go to club(s). They are willing to work with clubs. People can call ahead to order and they will provide for breaks, classes, meetings. They will deliver. Food items include pretzels & cookies. Keep up with ASO & Student Development. Can’t always come to club/ICC meetings. Please keep those things in mind. Happy to see all here!

### Club Reports-

- Native Americans: Club meeting went great! Monthly meetings – time changed to 1st Thursday @ 6:30pm, with the exception of one week when meeting will start @ 5:00 pm. Bernadine: Confirm that’s listed on information sheet (in her hand).
- Alpha Iota: Group returned from event at Long Beach City College. Overall good experience.
- SNAC Fall 2008: Club wants to thank everyone for their support. Fundraisers complete with enough money for the pinning ceremony for every student in the class. Proud and pleased \*Thank You\* for the support! Bernadine: FYI – Nursing students must pay for their graduation (pinning) – imperative to hustle all year so they can do enough fundraisers to pay for pinning. There are 70 students in the class/club, so divide \$12,000 by 70 to figure \$172 per student.

#### IV. ACTION ITEMS

##### 4.1 Club Activations/Activities

Steven Spire – AVC Math, Science, and Pre-Med Club, advisor to be Dr. Asani. He has 6 officers and paperwork is good to go. We encouraged them to expand the club to include Engineering since there was a foundation account and they agreed to change their name to Math, Science, Engineering and Pre-Med Club.

- Native Americans moved to approve, seconded by Speech Club, Motion approved 10/0/0.

New group: Group goal = shine our lamp for entertainment, games, events, school spirit, generate more enthusiasm. Question: BSU stands for Black Student Union Drill Team – no advisor. Dr. Z – needs clarification of purpose for benefit of audience: Club wants to perform at athletic events, other entertainment & scheduled activities.

\*Pending an advisor.\* Mandy sent an e-mail seeking advisor, awaiting response ... actually, they are more interested in dance than drill team. Need to get the paperwork to Dr. Z. Will work on this more, separately from today's meeting. Dr. Z: Okay to use covered patio for now for practice. First get approved as club, then move on to activities. Expansion by Dr. Z: "BSU" has history, name might create problems. If you want to \*dance,\* will be easier to get an advisor with that focus. Membership = 8 members of group, but will increase. Name revision: AVC DANCE. Clearly club, don't want to give wrong impression

- Moved to approve by Native Americans, seconded by Significant Ambitions, Motion passed 10/0/0.

Bernadine: Congratulations! Welcome. Question: Will this include other performing arts, or dance only? Answer: Dance only. Club member: We're open-minded, will listen to ideas.

For the next meeting membership for ICC is now at 20 clubs, Quorum is now at 11.

##### 4.2 Club Activities

- AVC Speech Club: Sunday, November 2 – participating in tournament at CSUN, 8:00 – 5:30 pm. Trip request till pending. Moved by AVC Speech, Seconded by Native Americans, Motion passed xx/0/0.
- PSO: Visiting CSUB-AVC on Thursday, October 30, fundraiser to sell jewelry & watches. On campus activity, participating with CSUB. Dr. Heidary: Students want to join. Dr. Z: Can't be members, but can participation and co-sponsor activities. Dr. Heidary: Can anyone attend? Dr. Z: Yes, open events Also want to sell T-shirts & hoodies with club logo. Attain approval – how? Dr. Z will send to Steve Standerfer. Clubs are not allowed to use AVC in their name without college approval. Person in charge of that is Steve Standerfer. Dr. Z will submit the artwork, approval is not usually a problem. Dr. Heidary they want to sell watches & jewelry as an ongoing fundraisers, will advertise & sell, with portion of proceeds going to club. Watches are priced \$40, of that \$10 goes into club account. Gold jewelry = 14kt emblems priced \$80, \$10 to PSO.
- PSO moves to sell jewelry as ongoing fundraiser, approve the logo and sell t-shirts and sweatshirts, and be reimburse the club advisor for a charm to give as a gift to their speaker and popcorn (up to \$150), seconded by Speech Club, Motion approved 10/0/0.

Also, FYI: clubs have access to 200 free copies per month, 50 can be in color, plus showcases & outdoor kiosk are available locations to display items.

AVC Dance – wants open event fundraiser for team on Friday, November 7 selling lollipop roses – ongoing. Dr. Z indicated that they have too few members. SNAC asked about them needing an advisor first? Dr. Z – advisor expected, but \*caution\* - Friday night event/show? Bernadine: Where? Answer: Cafeteria, on stage. Dr. Z – Time? = Answer: 8:00pm = Location has possible conflict due to event next day: Craft Fair Black Box Theater = already booked Student Lounge = already booked, size issue Discussion of alternate date: Fri, Nov. 14 – AVC Gamers have Student Lounge reserved 5:00 – 9:30pm Thurs, Nov. 13 – promo things happening in Library Plaza, Bernadine: Dance Thursday? Native Americans: Percussion Event @ 12:00 noon. Dance Club – plan to have tryouts weeks starting Nov. 10, 17 & 24. Dr. Z – gym has classes, unless they have an advisor there is a concern. Question: Student Lounge available? Dr. Z – room size too small, can't clear Club – day or night? Friday is only evening open. Other events conflict Dr. Z – will discuss with Dean Chelette, check out what physical space is available. Nov. 13 & 14 lollipops sales event though they are looking for advisor, wait & see how tryouts go. To be club, need more members & advisor. Club: Our promo Nov 13 & 14? Dr. Z - \*IF\* advisor & space available Club: We'll need a table for sign-ups Bernadine: In Library Plaza – Nov. 13, PSO: Wait ... paperwork still pending, SNAC: People need to sign up \*before\* the date. Bernadine: Sign up to \*get enough\* members, then club can have their event. Two more members needed in order to have events. Dr. Z – Mandy will call you to explain the paperwork and the necessary steps to take.

Motion: Approve Nov. 13 & Nov. 14 events pending paperwork and advisor

- Native Americans moved to approve, pending paperwork and an advisor, the AVC Dance Club to have an dance event in the Cafeteria on November 14 from 8-11 p.m., to sell lollipops, and on November 13 to have a pre dance show on at noon in the Library Plaza to get more members, seconded by AVC Speech Club, Motion passed 10/0/0.

Bernadine told the AVC Dance group: Please appreciate that the ICC has been VERY gracious to you today. Work to get those two members. If all of the paperwork was done, you would be able to move, but it took others to speak on your behalf.

PSO/Dr. Heidary: : Guest speaker October 21, would like to make gift of a charm, will need reimbursement, withdraw money for honorarium, buy popcorn machine for [upcoming] movie night. Bernadine: College has one, Dr. Heidary: For the club to own, use for future activities Dr. Z – concern – club buys, property goes home with someone equals theft. ASO has popcorn machine, but it's ... temperamental Bernadine – can buy popcorn for event, inexpensive at Smart & Final Dr. Z – college has portable machine, maybe can borrow. Can discuss with ASO. Ask Mandy about moving it – 220 volt. Dr. Heidary: Not that big, don't want to waste food Dr. Z – Snack Shack will be open Dr. Heidary: Club means to purchase (described small air-pop popper) only. Bernadine: Oh, I have one at home. Let me see if it works. Dr. Heidary: Someone would buy corn & sodas, up to \$150 reimbursement

- PSO moves to approve reimbursement for chain, popcorn machine & sodas for their movie night and gift for their speaker, seconded by Alpha Iota, discussion: the club minutes must reflect approval for reimbursement, Motion passes. 10/0/0.
