IV. REPORTS

Advisor's Report: Dr. Zimmerman:

Announced that AVC's Accreditation is in progress, and will be on campus Monday through Thursday beginning 10/18 for a Big Audit. She also encouraged ICC reps to urge their members to read the 400 page Self Study that may be found in the Library and online at myAVC. The Self Study talks about how well the college does and in what areas there needs to be improvements. Pay particular attention to Standard IIB because this is where "we" are and there is a wealth of useful info there for students on club affairs. We need to maintain accreditation because this status makes our diplomas more meaningful and gives more credibility to AVC. The Accreditation Commission sends representatives to talk to students and ask questions, and well as the authority to have access to classroom and common areas on campus. Dr. Zimmerman also reports that she spoke to Tina, who takes the cash boxes and she will, in the future, count the money in front of a club member immediately, and then give them a pink receipt. Lastly, if clubs do not turn in paperwork and keep attendance, their club will be deactivated and their accounts closed.

Chair's Report: VP of Club Affairs, Karole Obrikat

Wishes to reiterate that ASO/SAC is still looking for volunteers for the Homecoming Committee to plan events for that week. Student Court will begin soon and needs an ICC rep on the Court, and applications are being accepted. David Dorst from Skills Club and Brian Taylor from Club Check Mate expressed interest in applying for the position tomorrow. The Student Court will

hear minor infractions and enforce disciplinary action for smoking violations and other minor offenses made on campus. Karole wishes to congratulate club's who reactivated today and looks forward to working with everyone. She was happy to attend Marauder's Music's first meeting this afternoon, and was glad to have made the suggestion of a Spring talent show, which was gladly accepted. Karole plans to attend the meetings of clubs in the future, as time allows.

- Marauder's Music: Had a successful event planning meeting and is also looking at fundraisers this fall.
- AVC Campus Christians: Happy to report that last week they had 5 members and this week they have 27. Next week they will elect officers. In addition, they would like to have a Camus Clean-up event soon.
