<u>Alpha Iota</u> motioned for their Writing Tournament on Wednesday, Dec. 11th, from 1 to 5 PM in HS 109 and 105, where participants will be given 5 minutes to write a short

creative piece, registration is \$5, the event is open to the public; AVC STEM seconded, motion passed unanimously.
