An Antelope Valley College student must complete a minimum of 39 of 48 required units of General Education as part of a Bachelor's degree requirement from the California State University System. In addition to these required 39 units of lower division general education courses, students must complete 9 units of upper division general education courses at a California State University campus to reach a combined total of the required 48 units. AVC will certify general education, including appropriate courses taken at other accredited institutions, for students who meet the 12 unit residency requirement at Antelope Valley College. No class may be used to satisfy requirements in more than one of the five general areas. Courses used to satisfy the American Institutions requirement may also apply to category D .
